New Building Basics

- Completion summer 2012
- 113,000 square foot hospital that will attach to the current Sanford Clinic Aberdeen building
- 48-bed, three-story hospital
- Construction Company: Ball Construction Services
- Architect: Hoefer Wysocki Architects (HWA)

Financing

- Total: approximately \$55 million project

Services Include

- Inpatient and Outpatient Surgery
 - Four finished and equipped operating rooms
 - One Cardiac Catheterization Lab
 - One Procedure Room
 - Nine Post Anesthesia Care Unit (PACU) stations/phase one recovery
 - 21 pre-procedure/phase two recovery rooms
- Patient Rooms
 - Includes 32 adult
 - Four adaptable rooms to create secure pediatric unit
 - Obstetrics
 - Eight Labor, Delivery, Recovery, Postpartum beds
 - Nursery with eight cribs
 - Intensive Care
 - Eight ICU beds
- Emergency Care
 - Acute Care
 - Urgent Care Area
 - Two Trauma rooms
 - Seven Exam rooms
- Outpatient Infusion
- Respiratory Therapy
- Diagnostic testing (Echo, Vascular, Stress, Ultrasound)

Building Fun Facts

- Miscellaneous
 - The total hospital square footage is 113,000 square feet or 2.5 acres
 - 6,296 square feet or over 3.5 tons of brick
- Structural
 - Over 620 tons of structural steel, 21 tons of bar joist
- Finishes
 - 1,133 square feet of art glass
 - 10,375 square feet of floor tile more than enough to cover 2 basketball courts
 - 345,568 square feet of gypsum board almost enough to cover 8 acres
- Plumbing
 - 45,458 ft or 8.6 miles of copper pipe
 - 17,049 ft or 3.2 miles of PVC pipe
- Electrical
 - 2,855 Light Fixtures
 - Over 2,100 Electrical Fixtures
